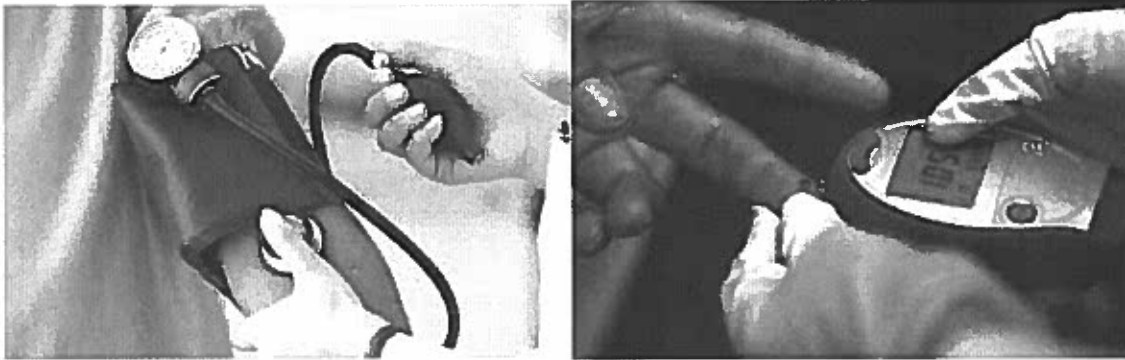
## **Teacher Strike for Secondary Students**




# NOTICE OF NOMINATION MEETING

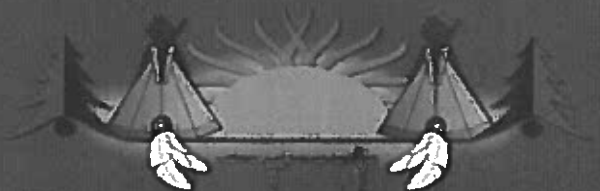
